

SUGGESTED SCHOOL RULES OF COEXISTENCE TO AVOID CONFLICT

It is important that these rules come from students, although here are a few suggestions. The number of rules doesn't need to be long; less than ten is sufficient. What is most important is to have four or five which are easy to learn, rather than a large quantity of which they'll only remember a few. The class will be split into small groups in order to create and list the rules more effectively.

- Stay calm.
- Listen to each other.
- Respect conversational turn-taking.
 - Speak in friendly tones.
- Use words to understand the others.
 - Ask an adult for help.
 - Leave the room if necessary.
