

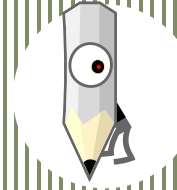
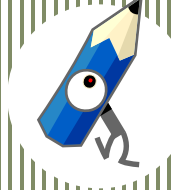
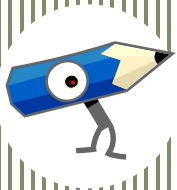


RULES OF LIVING TOGETHER
